Anti-Corruption Code: Essential Key Points

SANCTIONED BY THE SWEDEN CRICKET FEDERATION (SCF)

1. ABSOLUTE BINDING JURISDICTION

All tournament participants—including players, team staff, match officials, player agents, and franchise owners—are strictly bound by the ICC and Sweden Cricket Federation (SCF) Anti-Corruption Codes. Every individual must know their specific responsibilities; ignorance of the rules is not an acceptable defense.

2. CORE PROHIBITED OFFENSES

Under the governing Anti-Corruption Code, severe penalties apply to the following core offenses: Match-fixing or spot-fixing, betting on any cricket match globally, the misuse or sharing of inside information, failing to report a corrupt approach, and failing to fully cooperate with an official investigation.

3. ZERO TOLERANCE FOR CORRUPT CONDUCT

Participants must not, under any circumstances, engage in any form of corrupt conduct, match-fixing, or spot-fixing. The integrity and true spirit of cricket remain the central priority of the tournament ecosystem.

4. COMMERCIAL BETTING SEPARATION

While the tournament features official "Betting & Engagement" commercial partners, all participants are absolutely prohibited from placing bets on any cricket match, anywhere in the world, at any time. This includes utilizing official league betting platforms or engaging in promotional activities that compromise participant integrity.

5. STRICT INSIDE INFORMATION RULES

The use of inside information for betting or personal gain is strictly prohibited. This includes disclosing confidential data regarding team selection, pitch conditions, tactics, or medical updates to any external person (including via social media, reels, or digital streams) before it is publicly announced by the league.

6. MANDATORY APPROACH REPORTING

Participants must report any approach, invitation, or information regarding corrupt conduct to the Anti-Corruption Unit (ACU) without any unnecessary delay. Failure to report an approach is an immediate, standalone offense under the code.

7. CORPORATE & FRANCHISE ACCOUNTABILITY

This code explicitly extends to all franchise groups—including management staff from Stockholm City, Stockholm United, Gothenburg Phoenix, Malmö Mavericks, Västerås United, Uppsala Tigers. Franchise executives are liable if they attempt to influence match variables or fail to report corrupt approaches within their teams.

8. PMOA DEVICE RESTRAINTS & DIGITAL RULES

To safeguard advanced analytics and live scoring feeds, the use of mobile phones, smartwatches, or any communication equipment within the Player and Match Officials Area (PMOA) at Norsborg Cricket Ground is strictly banned during match hours.

9. GIFT AND HOSPITALITY DISCLOSURES

Giving, accepting, or failing to disclose any gift, hospitality benefit, or token of value above the threshold defined by the code is a punishable offense. Any transaction occurring under circumstances that bring a participant, a franchise, or the tournament into disrepute will be fully prosecuted.

10. LIABILITY OF INTENT AND ATTEMPT

The exact moment a participant agrees, attempts, or conspires to commit an Anti-Corruption Code offense, they become fully liable for the consequences. Liability is enforced regardless of whether the corrupt act successfully takes place or impacts the match.

11. COMPLICITY AND COVER-UP PENALTIES

If a participant knowingly assists, encourages, aids, or covers up any anti-corruption offense committed by another individual, they will be treated as if they committed the crime themselves and will face identical disciplinary actions and punishments.

12. COOPERATION AND INVESTIGATION MANDATES

Full, unhindered cooperation with any ACU inquiry is mandatory. Obstructing an investigation, destroying potential electronic evidence (such as chat histories, call logs, or emails), or providing false information constitutes a severe, independent violation of the code.

13. OFFICIAL EMERGENCY CONTACT CHANNELS

For immediate queries, anonymous reporting, or feedback, participants must utilize the official tournament communication lines or the ICC Integrity App.

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
